Botswana is a cattle country whose economy depends on the meat industry. Batswana also depends on livestock for their livelihood. Stock theft therefore affects the economy of the country and the livelihood of Batswana.

With a veiw of fighting stock theft in the country, the Administration of Justice has established Specialized Stock Theft Courts in the most affected parts of the country to deal with cases involving stock only.

The courts which were launched in August 2009 are now operating in the following stations:

- Francistown Magistrates Court.
- LetIhakane Magistrates Court – this covers the whole of Boteti region.
- Mochudi Magistrates Court.
- Molepolole Magistrates Court
- covers Kweneng region.
- Selibe Phikwe Magistrates Court
 to cover Mmadinare, Serule and
 Bobirwa areas
- Palapye Magistrate Court – to cover Tswapong, Mahalapye and Serowe areas
- Jwaneng Magistrates Court - to cover Southern Kgalagadi and Gantsi

Experience from the operation of the Courts has shown that a lot of cases are completed quickly by specialized courts when the exhibits are readily available. The courts sit where the offences were committed and places which are accessible to the members of the public. The public is free to attend and witness justice being done.

In order to address the escalatingtheft of stock in the country, the sock theft Act Cap 09:01 of the laws of Botswana has a number of provisions that are in place to control the menace."
